Level 2 (NCFE) Award: Introduction to Domestic Renewable, Low Carbon Technologies

Booking fee of £30 required to secure your place and contribute to accreditation costs. (Usually, this course would cost £270 per person but this has been covered through funding from The National Lottery Community Fund).
